Halasy-Szigeti House

The house was built in the middle of the 18th century and in 1785 it is owned by the noble heirs of Jánosné Koller. Between 1800 and 1840 it was owned by noble counselor Martin Halasy, then János Halasy. Baroness Maria Reviczky lives there, but in 1851 János Holczer buys it from the Halasy family. At the beginning of the turn of the century, the Liptays, Ringelhans lived here. The house also had a stable and an exit to the Eger stream from the back of the site. At the end of the 19th century it was owned by the Szigeti family. It was rebuilt in the early 20th century. On the street front is a statue of Immaculata, made by József Steinhauser.
